The conference rate is \$105 single/double. Be sure to say you are with ASBA when you make your reservation.

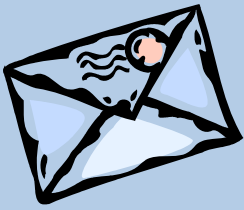
GUEST MEALS: Members' guests may attend meal functions for an additional charge.
